OPERATING RESERVE

Our Operating Reserve at the end of 2020 was \$96,339.86. We anticipated higher expenses for 2022. For financial stability, WRCC holds \$100K for unforseen operating expenses/major repairs. The balance of the reserve was raised to rebuild over the next two years, including new ministries and salaries. Because of REBOOT, we are well prepared and have a current Operating Reserve of...

WEST RIDGE MORTGAGE

We refinanced our mortgage in anticipation of multiple rate hikes in 2022 and because of a forthcoming renewal. West Ridge took the opportunity to premptively refinance at the end of 2021 to take advantage of the historically low interest rates.



190 individuals took next steps toward authenticity and growth as part of a Community group or a Volleyball Team.

Hired NextGen Director, Lindsay Alexander, to create a more cohesive transition for our students from birth to high school that will create life change in our kids lives.

Continued to partner with Huff Elementary to help make a difference in one of Elgin's poorest neighborhoods.

The Fourth Annual Toy Sale at Huff Elementary filled a 16-foot storage pod and a box truck with new and gently used toys!

We served over 120 families to help make their Christmas extra special.

Personally delivered over 1,500 pounds of food to Huff Families for holiday breaks and collected 94 new coats to help keep kids warm.

Served those beyond our borders in Nicaragua.

Raised over \$100,000 at Wine to Water Event for Nica Angels to continue to invest in providing clean water, improved education, and economic development. (100% of this goes directly to Nicaragua!)

140 children in four communities are sponsored every month, and provides them food, clothing, school supplies, and more.
